5 STANSTED SCHOOL

The Chairman suspended the meeting to allow members of the public to speak.

It was reported there were now 19 children in the school. The parents were in the process of undertaking a survey. More would use the school if there was a pre-school. Mrs Osborne was leaving at Easter. Mr Mattick had researched on academy status; the school would have to close and re-open. It would require central government to seek a suitable academy group and there were several in the area. Due to the size the school was now almost certainly unviable. It would appear that the Local authority and Diocese had planned well ahead for closure, but special measures was not a step to closure but a step towards improvement. All the families who had removed their children would bring them back if the correct leadership was put in

place. Mrs Nelson thanked the Parish Council for being the only official body doing anything about the situation.

The Chairman thanked members of the public and reconvened the meeting.

Cllr Bott referred to the draft response, which had been circulated to members prior to the meeting. The response was agreed and would be delivered by the deadline on 6th March. Clle Mrs Falconer thanked Cllr Bott for drafting it. It was then proposed by Cllr Bott, seconded by Cllr Osborne and agreed unanimously that the Parish Council seek to have the school listed as a community asset.
