What's it all about

The aim of the game in Lawn Bowls is pretty clear - get your own bowls as close as possible to the small white or yellow ball called the jack. The bend on the bowls means achieving that is literally not straight forward and that's the challenge in our sport.

Players take it in turns to bowl and when all the bowls have been played, you or your team get one point (or shot) for each of their bowls that is lying closer to the jack than the opponent's closest bowl.

Why you'll love it

With plots, intrigue and surprise endings -I awn bowls can be a thriller. Tactics play a huge part in the game, along with razor-sharp hand and eye coordination.

- Draw shot a bowl that reaches the jack
- Shot Bowl the closest to the jack
- Skip team captain
- Wick occurs when the bowl collides with a stationary bowl, causing it to change direction

The tools of the game

- Jack: Yellow or white ball used as the target, supplied by the Club
- Wood (Bowl): there are different sizes and weights, ask a member for advice. Sets of 4 woods are available at the club to practise playing
- Yourself!

Dress Code

- To protect the green, when on the green you are expected to wear smooth sole shoes
- When playing in league or competitions, members are expected to wear club colours
- The wearing of jeans is not permitted when playing on the green

Game in play on the Green

There is an etiquette to playing bowls and we will help you to find your way through it. However, the most important consideration is to respect the game and other players. You will need to keep quiet and avoid movement when a player is about to bowl – if you remember this, then you are more than half-way to becoming a bowler.
