### **Police Update**

Motorcyclist PC Young carried out speed enforcement in Nesscliffe on Saturday 9th September. During approximately 4 hrs, 37 offenders caught. The lowest captured was set at 37mph and the highest was 55mph. The motorcyclist team are in much demand and we use them when we can in Bicton, Minsterley, Forton Bridge and other areas.

In September, the Shrewsbury Rural officers put out two dedicated vehicles as part of a Rural Disruption Operation. The officers each covered over 100 miles of patrol, covering back lanes and remote farms across the division. Areas that have been subjected to recent thefts were paid particular attention.

Rural Crime is an issue, with properties targeted in the area. This is often farms and outbuildings with large plant and tools taken. Several high value machines have been recovered due to having trackers fitted.
