* T3 (oak) and other linear trees (said to be insignificant or low quality trees). These form part of a linear group and although said to be of little value or causing excessive shading (T3), they make a positive contribution to the character of the local area giving a high amenity value. There is no supporting evidence that the trees are in an unsafe condition or that they pose an unacceptable risk of falling at this time.. Removal is in our view therefore unjustified and considered to be contrary to the aims of saved Policy EV19 of the SNLP and the proposed works are not in line with the Councils Corporate Policies
