Discussion	The latest information showed that the only site in Nonington that was going forward to the Local Development Plan was the Prima site. This site had inherent problems which were highlighted last year with drainage, land contamination, type of development and historical architectural features. Further discussion was held regarding the HELAA and the impact further development, particularly in Aylesham, would have on the traffic volumes through Nonington. A flier was being produced which would be delivered to all residents in the village outlining the issues and asking that, if they objected, to write to KCC, DDC and Natalie Elphicke MP with their comments. Kent Association of Local Councils (KALC) were also objecting on the behalf of councils in Kent to the proposed changes to planning laws which would remove the majority of powers of Local and District councils to object to proposed developments. Discussion	Cllr Tee said that he had identified locations in Nonington where the 4 speed strips could be placed, cost born by KCC. These would gather data for future plans to slow down traffic. These locations would be confirmed after KCC Highways visited and confirmed. It was decided that, if necessary, another speed strip could be purchased by the Parish Council to enhance data collection. Any surveys would have to be undertaken after lockdown to make the data representative. Cllr Tee asked Speedwatch to stop any work once the strips were in place so that data would not be compromised by their presence. It was also suggested that we investigate the possible purchase of an air quality monitor to ascertain what issues we have through the village.
