CARNIVAL COURT RULES AND CONDITIONS

- Applicants must be available to take part in activities on the Carnival weekend (15th and 16th September 2018) and may be asked to take part in other activities during the following year.
- The Parish Council will provide an outfit for the Carnival, and the activities throughout the year. Parents/guardians are responsible for ensuring that the outfits are cleaned between activities.
- The applicant must behave appropriately for a member of the Carnival Court. Inappropriate behaviour, such as swearing, will mean that the applicant will be asked to leave the Carnival Court.
- The Bishopstoke Parish Council Carnival Working Group will provide a sash and a tiara or a crown, which must be worn during the Carnival weekend activities, and at other times when undertaking an activity as requested by the Working Group. The sash and tiara/crown must not be worn at any other time and must be returned to the Parish Council upon request.
- The parent or guardian for the applicant must take responsibility at all times for their children during any of the Carnival activities, both at the weekend or at other times during the year. The parent or guardian may be asked to get their child to each event.
- Carnival Court members may be required to attend Fair Oak, Hedge End or West End Carnivals in 2018 and may need to arrange transport to those Carnivals.
- The parent or guardian must give permission for their child to be chaperoned for certain activities, by a chaperone appointed by the Parish Council. This will be agreed with the parent or guardian in advance of the activity.
- The parent or guardian for the applicant must agree to all rules and conditions.
- The above list may be subject to amendment any amendment will be notified to the parent or guardian for the applicant.
