Eventually this will be a quiet area where anyone can sit and enjoy the peace and quiet of the village.

There are 3 vacant plots at present which can be subdivided into smaller areas or taken on by multiple holders. Anyone can ask for a plot and the allotment association are very happy to have groups as well as individuals. Sharing the work rather than ever smaller plots is probably the way forward as there will probably always be someone around for harvesting the goodies as well as hoeing out the baddies! New villagers especially welcome!

Jonathon Henton continues as treasurer. An annual report is pending as subs are collected around now.

The allotments are now an Asset of Community Value and feature in the recent Neighbourhood Development plan.

The Parish Council have organised the lengthsmen to keep the boundary hedges in check. Thanks to Alan Young.
