Both the Clerk and the resident have been trying to get answers from Nottinghamshire County Council but have not received any replies to their multiple messages. Notts County Council have sent a few leaflets in the post, the Clerk has displayed these on the noticeboards inside the village hall and the rest have been put on the Post Office counter and in the leaflet display at the village hall. It is a concern that this service seems to have been launched very quietly as it means that residents of the village may not be aware that the service is now available to them.
