#### **News from the Parish Council**

On Friday 11th November, there was a wellattended Armistice Service which saw poppy wreaths laid by many village organisations, including the Parish Council, Royal British Legion and former members of the armed services, and Stoke Park Junior School.

Meanwhile, Bishopstoke Parish Council is pressing on with designing its Neighbourhood Plan. Following a meeting earlier in the year, volunteers are being selected to form a group to help drive the process forward. Cllr Sue Toher is leading the group, and is happy to hear from anyone with any thoughts on what should be included.

Back in September there was another successful Bishopstoke Carnival. The weather was damp on Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> for the River Floats, Duck Races and Car Show, but Sunday 11<sup>th</sup> was sunny and dry. Many of you enjoyed the parade, and the fete that followed in Glebe Meadow

The Parish Council would like to thank everyone who got involved in any way, but especially to Claire Potterton of Jiggly Wrigglers for stepping in at the last minute when another act had to pull out.

The street collection raised £445.12, all of which was given out as grants to various groups.

In addition to Carnival grants, the Parish Council is able to grant money to local groups and organisations to help with running costs, or even unexpected emergencies. So far this year, the Council has added extra money to the Carnival Street Collection so that Age Concern, ARK Eastleigh and New Hope could each receive £200 to help their ongoing projects.

Also, the Guides Association of Bishopstoke has been given £350 to purchase equipment that will help maintain their grounds, and Stoke Park Infants Association has received £1000 to purchase part of their newly designed play area — the Council is looking forward to seeing the new Storyteller's Throne.
