# FRIENDS OF ALL SAINTS CHURCH

## Fundraising to restore the Church lychgate

You might not know that the beautiful church in Cuddesdon is a Grade I listed building. It was built in 1180 over the foundations of an earlier 12th-century church, and it has very much looked the way it does today since the 13th century with some small, later additions in the 14th and 15th centuries.



The Friends of All Saints Church (FOASC) is a local community group looking to ensure that this community asset survives to serve the community for the next thousand years. We're keen to ensure that the church remains a place to be enjoyed by, and at the heart of, the parish.



Our first project aims to raise £25k to repair the lychgate, which sits at the entrance to the churchyard. It is in urgent need of restoration, and we need your help!

You can find a report in our upcoming newsletter about our successful "Cuddesdon Open Gardens" event which took place on the 30th June and raised £500. Huge thanks to all those involved in making the day a triumph – particularly Gillie and Nicko!

# PARISH COUNCIL

From October's meeting:

- The District Councillor Community Fund is still open for applications. The Community Orchard working group agreed to apply for funding to cover some of the costs towards the orchard project. The lease agreement was approved by the councillors. The working group confirmed that it would be applying for additional funding from the Trust for Oxfordshire's Environment
- The Village Hall Committee confirmed that a request for funding towards new doors for the Hall had been submitted to the District Councillor Community Fund.
- Bonfire night had been set for 3rd November. Tickets would be £5 per person with under 10s free of charge. A card reader would be available for payments on the evening. Beer was kindly being provided by Ben (the new landlord at the pub).
- Two poppy wreaths had been purchased, one for the Parish Council and one for the Church.
- Councillors discussed the use of CCTV to assist in deterring fly tipping. Further research was ongoing and the Clerk would contact SODC for further advice. SODC were considering installation of a camera on Chippinghurst Hill.
- The Clerk's new mobile contact number was 07831 437575.
- Budget preparation, a report from Bonfire Night and a Community Orchard update would be discussed at the next meeting.



# THE GREAT GREEN TOMATO CHUTNEY ADVENTURE

The humble green tomato that you pick off your plants out in the garden at the end of the year. If it makes your taste buds do a happy dance, congratulations! You've just made green tomato chutney. If not, well, there's always ketchup.

## **Step 6: The Grand Finale**

Finally, jar up your chutney and admire your handiwork. You've turned those unripe, unloved green tomatoes into a tangy, spicy masterpiece. Serve it with cheese, slather it on sandwiches, or just eat it straight from the jar – no judgment here.

So there you have it, folks. Making chutney with green tomatoes is not just a recipe, it's an adventure. And who knows? You might just start a new trend. Move over, red tomatoes – green is the new black.


