#### 7. Cemetery & Village maintenance

A Parishioner has made a complaint about the grass in the cemetery, which was cut shortly afterwards. The same parishioner then complained about nettles around a specific grave. Clerk has spoken to the gardener who will investigate this for us. Clerk to remind parishioners that it is their own responsibility to maintain their own areas. The Parish Council has arranged to pay for 8 cuts of the grass a year.

It appears that Arthur Aldersons seat is unsafe. Cllr Carlisle will ring his son and ask him how he would like to proceed after he has carried out an inspection.

Clerk has invoiced DCC £500.00 for the seed mix and will purchase it from the recommended supplier. Stuart Priestley has recommended the vegetation be sprayed, then sprayed again and then rotovated in September.

# 8 Allotments

Finally, some good news. Richard Wilson, Chairman of the Lords in Trust has agreed to pay for the repairs to the wall in full. He has indicated the he is happy for the land at the Clint to be used for grazing. Richard will also send a new lease for us to review. Clerk to let the allotment holders that access may be needed to repair the walls and contact Mr Watson to let him know to start the work after making the necessary arrangements with Mr Foster. Invoice to be sent directly to Youngs.

It has been reported that the new lock has not been put on the gate at the Clint. Clerk to also the Linda to remove the tree now the weather is dry and repair the wall.
