Crime

There have been one hundred and four crimes reported across the whole of the Wolds Ward throughout September & October. Of these, the following have occurred in Barnoldby-le-Beck.

There have been three reports of harassment due to a long running dispute over boundaries between neighbours.

Another report of harassment is connected to a scam of demanding money with threats over social media.

There were no reports of ASB.
