(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING) THE ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

TEMPORARY ORDER MAY 2024

Marron Civil Engineering works.

To allow drainage works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Lower Rainham Road, Upchurch.

A closure is planned from 20th May 2024, with estimated completion by 9th June 2024, or where stated on a valid Permit (GE05081283275-01 - Marron Civil Engineering). The scheduled dates may vary for these works with appropriate signage displayed on site and the works will be displayed on One.Network

Lower Rainham Road will be closed in the vicinity of The Three Sisters Roundabout, to the extent indicated by signs and barriers on site.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while drainage works are undertaken by Marron Civil Engineering.

The alternative route for any through traffic is via Otterham Quay Lane, A2 High Street, B2004 Station Road, Lower Rainham Road and vice versa.

Pedestrian access will be maintained during the works.
