Community Engagement - Event and/or Survey for Residents to Complete - Involving the local community can be time consuming but is vital to secure support for new initiatives as well as providing a source of ideas, volunteers and resources. There are several techniques that may be employed, including: • A household survey, that can generate a local mailing list of interested people • Community workshops on particular topics • "Walking workshops" with a tour of the local area • Talks by specialist professionals • Online maps for people to locate and post ideas and suggestions • Neighbourhood and wellbeing planning events • Open house events from residents who have made low carbon changes • Supporting all the above through newsletters, social media and websites

**Parish Council Net Zero Goals** – MBC Sustainability Officers drafting a plan/template for Parish Councils and other resources.

**Local Climate Action Plan** – NALC has drafted this template and the Admin Assistant has put into a document. This could be a useful tool and the Environmental Group to revisit at a future date.

**Good Practice Template Review** – NALC has drafted and could be a useful tool in the future.
