2. Disclosure of Interest:

3. Minutes:

The Minutes of the Parish Council meeting held on the 27th September 2021 were approved.

4. Matters arising from the minutes not included on the agenda:

5. Chairman's Communications:

The Clerk reported that the next meeting of the South Shropshire Area Committee of Parish and Town Councils will be held virtually on Monday 6th December 2021.

6. Planning Items:

7. Highway/Amenity Items:

Land at Sycamore Grove Knowbury – The Clerk had discussed play equipment with two parent representatives, and it was proposed to initially install a small slide and two swings and a cradle swing on the land this being funded by the Parish Council. Any further equipment would be subject to fund raising and grant applications although grants were now difficult to obtain for this type of facility.

Amenity Items: - Concern about overgrown hedges along the pavement of Tenbury Road Clee Hill and the overgrown bridleway Springfield Park/Tenbury Road. The Clerk will report to the Shropshire Council footpaths officer.

Improvement and repairs to the phone box at Caynham and the installation of replacement notice board at Caynham were still outstanding.

Climate Change: - With the emphasis on Climate Change and the impact to Parish and Town Council areas this item will now appear on the Parish council agenda as a permanent item.

8. Financial Items:

The Clerk had produced a schedule of Payments made since the last meeting which were confirmed by the Council and a schedule of Income and Expenditure compared with the Budget which showed bank balances of £56,883 as at the 29th November 2021.

The January meeting of the Parish Council will consider the Precept requirement for the Financial Year 2022/23.
