Project Logo. Action : Cllr. Langridge

Make the public aware at fetes, social gatherings, village libraries, village hall notice boards etc. Main focus: roads, transport, traffic, community safety, affordable housing, environment, schooling, small businesses

Involve PCSO Ray Nuttall and Victoria Lawson ACRK.

Keep the Parish Council web site updated

Set dates for early Autumn `Parish Vision Open Day: Come Along and Have Your Say`

Advertise dates on Village web sites

Hire exhibition stands from the Camden Centre

Involve local businesses, doctors, churches, schools

Produce a brochure – A1 folded (like a map) less expensive
