# National Under 25 Singles Glory For Ruby

Over the weekend of Saturday 22nd and Sunday 23rd January 2022, we were the proud hosts of the national under 25 singles finals. We have always prided ourselves on our junior section so to host such a prestigious event can only be good for the club. The event was well supported and one of our own came away with one of the two competed for trophies.

Ruby became national under 25 singles champion for the first time, adding the title to her already impressive CV. Jordan had come through qualifying in the men's event too but unfortunately lost at the quarter final stage against beaten finalist James Harston.

In the last 16, Ruby played M. Linford from Acle. Despite drawing the first set, the Spalding star dominated the second set and set up a quarter final with Imogen Jenner from Swale. Ruby again showed her class to win in straight sets and secure her place in the semi-final where she would face Chloe Brett - the daughter of former men's world champion Nicky - from Huntingdon.

The first set was closely contested but Ruby picked up a three on the final end to win the set 9-4. She then showed her dominance and controlled the second set, winning it with an end to spare. That moved her in to the final, where she would play fellow junior and senior

international, and 2018/19 winner of the event, Devon Cooper from Hartlepool.

The supporters were treated to a high quality affair but Ruby was fantastic from the first end as she won the first set with an end to spare. Devon put up more of a fight in the second set as she went 6-0 up after two ends, but the home favourite was far too good as she won the set 12-6 to seal the championship match in straight sets and the title for the first time.

Ruby will now go on to represent England in the British Isles Championships in October.
