

Risk Assessments - Surveying rights of way



County Council

Basic rules which cover many risks:

- Take a mobile phone with you, having checked there is a signal and that batteries are charged
- Dress appropriately for the weather and take a snack and drink, bearing in mind the possibility of injury and that you may have to wait an hour or so for help Tell someone where you are going and when you expect to return
- Wear stout footwear which give adequate ankle protection and protection from falling objects such as tree branches
