## Havoc in the countryside: Skunk cabbage.

The Royal Horticultural Society has recently issued a warning about

this plant which is generally found near waterways, including private households with ponds. It's become particularly prevalent in the countryside. <u>Gardener's</u> <u>World</u> featured it on a programme aired on 19 May and the EU has banned its sale. To destroy: the advice is either to try selective herbicides, dig them out or burn them. Not ideal for the compost bin in case the seeds germinate.
