NEWS FROM CAROLYNE CULVER, YOUR DISTRICT COUNCILLOR

The biggest challenge facing us is climate change, and I'm pleased to report that there is now crossparty consensus at the council that we need to announce a climate emergency and come up with a plan to reduce our carbon footprint to zero by 2030. There is a growing number of councils around the country making the same commitment. Green councillors have submitted a motion for the next council meeting on 2 July to oppose Heathrow expansion. A third runway is not compatible with tackling climate change.

I'm working with the council to identify verges and green spaces where we can encourage wildflower growth in the future. If there are any verges or green space that you are concerned about because they have been cut too early, or which you think would make a good spot for wildflowers to be sown, let me know. As we all know, insect populations are crashing in this country and we need pollinators!

I am on the Western Area Planning Committee and the Planning Advisory Group, and will be taking every opportunity to make a case for more social and affordable housing, so that people aren't priced out of living in this area, and development that is more sustainable from an environmental and wildlife perspective.


