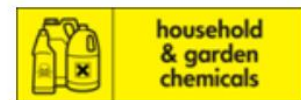

Main Contaminants

- X Nappies
- X Wood
- X Glass*

- X Textiles, Clothing and Shoes*

Plastics

- X Plastic Bags
- X Food Trays
- X Fruit and Veg punnets
- X Juice cartons
- X Polystyrene
- X Bubble wrap
- X Bottle lids
- X Plastic containers
- X Food pouches
- X Coat hangers

✓ Yes please

Please remember your recyclable material should be clean, dry, empty and loose. Please **do not** put your recyclable items in plastic carrier bags.

Paper

- ✓ Newspapers
- ✓ Envelopes
- ✓ Magazines and catalogues
- ✓ Junk mail

Cardboard

- ✓ Cereal boxes
- ✓ Egg boxes
- ✓ Cardboard tubes

Tins and cans

- ✓ Food tins
- ✓ Drinks cans
- ✓ Aerosol cans

Plastics

- ✓ Drinks bottles (e.g. pop, squash, milk)
- ✓ Shower gel and shampoo bottles
- ✓ Cleaning product bottles
- ✓ Yoghurt pots
- ✓ Margarine tubs

If in doubt – leave it out!
