Apologies received from Cllrs Brookes and Atkins and Borough Cllr Prescott Present. Cllrs Harbour, Austin, Snell, Nimmo and Scutt. **Minutes** of the previous meeting were approved and signed.

Great Spring Clean. Details had been given to several groups and Cllr Austin confirmed that Badlesmere would be litter picking on the weekend of the 11th/12th.

Kent Men of Trees Competition. Details have been received and it was agreed that the Parish Council would enter the 3 villages as in previous years.

Planning. 17/500656LBC. Post Office Cottages Lees Court Road. The Parish Council support the application for the removal of windows and insertion of by-fold doors.

Joint KALC/KFAS event. Cllr harbour attended this joint KALC event with Kent Federation of Amenity Societies. Cty Cllr Bowles and Carter and the Chairman of Thanet council were speakers. Finance and devolved powers were discussed and there was a good question and Answer session.

Speedwatch. It was reported that there is good support within the Parish boundary for the purchase and use of the Speedwatch equipment. Volunteers have already been identified within all 3 villages. Churchyard maintenance. The 3 year programme is now ended and the Parish Clerk will contact the Parochial Church Councils to obtain 3 estimates from each for the maintenance.
