Demolition of existing dwelling and erection of replacement dwelling with garage Calcot, Coldbridge Lane, Egerton, Kent

It was noted that there is no design and access statement. Boughton Malherbe Parish Council has no objection, in principle, to the proposed development subject to consideration of the following:

1) The proposal for bat boxes and house martin/swallow nest boxes indicates the presence or protected species already on the site.

2) There is a watercourse within 20m and 6 ponds within 250m.

3) BMPC believes these features require an ecological survey for protected species to be submitted. Any mitigation measures required to be made conditions of approval.
