#### **7. Highway/Amenity Items:**

a) Concern was raised about the time taken to repair the potholes near to the entrance of the village on the Caynham Road despite having been marked by Shropshire Council. The Clerk will take up the issue with Shropshire Council.

b) The Clerk to chase up the No Through Road sign for Dumblehole Lane which approved by Shropshire Council Highways.

c) Concern was again expressed at the amount of dog mess being left on the pathways and verges through areas of the village and advice would be sought from Street scene Shropshire Council about the provision of additional notices and “Poo Boxes”.
