164/12	<b>Report from Oxfordshire County Council</b>	<p>Cllr Lorraine Lindsay-Gale (OCC) reported as follows :-</p> <p><u>Oxfordshire Minerals &amp; Waste Plan</u> This will now be subject to a Public Inquiry that is likely to be held in February 2013 (see 167/12)</p> <p><u>2012/13 Localities Budget</u> There is still time for Stadhampton to bid for approximately £500 that remains be available from this budget.</p> <p><u>Church Farms Barns / Copson Lane Road Repairs</u> Cllr. MM asked LLG for assistance regarding the forthcoming repairs to Copson Lane as part of the ongoing easement negotiations with Vector Design Consultancy (VDC). Summarising the position MM reported that SPC had met with VDC 1/11/12 and that the only outstanding issues regarding the easement were to do with the actual road repairs. VDC have obtained a quotation for full repairs totalling £22,000 including VAT and contingencies but the County Council insist that the proposed contractors hold a £10m public liability insurance and, in addition, will only allow the repairs to go ahead if VDC or SPC then assume ongoing responsibility for the works for a five year period. LLG replied that the £10m public liability insurance required of the contractors was non-negotiable but that a 2 year guarantee of works would be acceptable. 165/12	<b>Report from South Oxfordshire District Council</b>	<p>Cllr Marc Hiles (SODC) had forwarded information regarding the South Oxfordshire Core Strategy Inspector's report. The report is a culmination of over 5 years' work where SODC tried to strike a balance between housing need and economic vitality while preserving the distinctive character of the district. Following extensive public consultation and several examination hearings held over the course of a year, SODC has now received the report which has found the core strategy to be sound subject to a number of minor modifications.</p> <p>The report and accompanying documents are available to view by visiting <a href="http://www.southoxon.gov.uk/corestrategy">www.southoxon.gov.uk/corestrategy</a> and a copy is also available to view at the Council's offices. The core strategy is now expected to be adopted by the council before the end of 2012 at which time it will become part of the development plan.</p> <p>Cllr Phil Cross (SODC) reported as follows :-</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Community Investment Fund - the allocations for 2013/14 have been set;</li> <li>• New welfare benefit changes will come into effect for 2013/14;</li> <li>• 'Help' Stop Hate Crime - Hate crime is a prejudice of disability, race or nationality, gender, religion or sexual orientation. The abuse can be verbal, physical or emotional and includes attacks to property, and written and electronic messages. Victims of hate crime who are reluctant to go to the police now have an alternative reporting service, a new 24 hour freephone helpline for anyone on the receiving end of, or witness to, hate crime.</li> </ul> <p>Whilst Cllr. PC was at the meeting planning application P12/S1417/RM was discussed. The application was for the 'Erection of an agricultural workers dwelling' at Wholesale Plants Ltd land, Ascott, OX44 7UH. There was strong consensus that that scale of the application was out of proportion and that it should be refused. There were also allegations that other development had already taken place on the site without permission and that SODC Planning needed to be alerted to the fact. It was decided that SPC should recommend <b>REFUSAL</b> by the deadline of 9/11/12 and suggest that SODC visit the site.</p> <p>Comments from the floor were then made to Cllr. PC that SODC Planning were allowing too many 'permissions by the back door' and that Planning Enforcement team seemed to be weak and sometimes ineffectual. Cllr.
