WORCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

Notice of closure of Footpaths BW-623 and BW-624, Bewdley, Worcestershire ("the highway") as an Emergency Measure.

It appears to Worcestershire County Council that because of the likelihood of danger to the public due to a damaged tree likely to shed branches onto the footpaths, therefore there is an urgent need to close the highway immediately in the following terms:-

- 1. The effect of the Notice is that no person shall proceed along Footpaths BW-623 and BW-624, Bewdley for their entire lengths.
- This provision shall continue in force for a maximum of 21 days (unless further provision is made for its continuance). It is anticipated that it will remain in force for 21 days.
- 3. Alternative routes: U10532 Snuff Mill Walk, U10501 Park Lane, Footpaths BW-626, BW-634, BW-629, BW-630 and BW-631 and vice versa.

Nothing in this Notice shall prevent at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the highway, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from and only from the highway.
