1. The Order

This allows the Traffic Authority (Norfolk County Council) to temporarily restrict or prohibit the use of a road and/or footpath.

2. The 'Propose To' Notice (PT)

This is the public Notice we must advertise at least seven days before making an Order.

3. The 'Has Made' Notice (HM)

This is the public Notice we must advertise within 14 days of making an Order.

Please note a new format is being introduced and for those looking for the plan, if a separate one is not attached, it can now be found on page 2 of the notices.

The proposed order comes into effect on the date shown. The date on the notices is when they will appear in the Eastern Daily Press. If we have to change any dates, we will let you know. If you have any questions about the order and notices, please contact Alison Wilton on (01603) 222591.

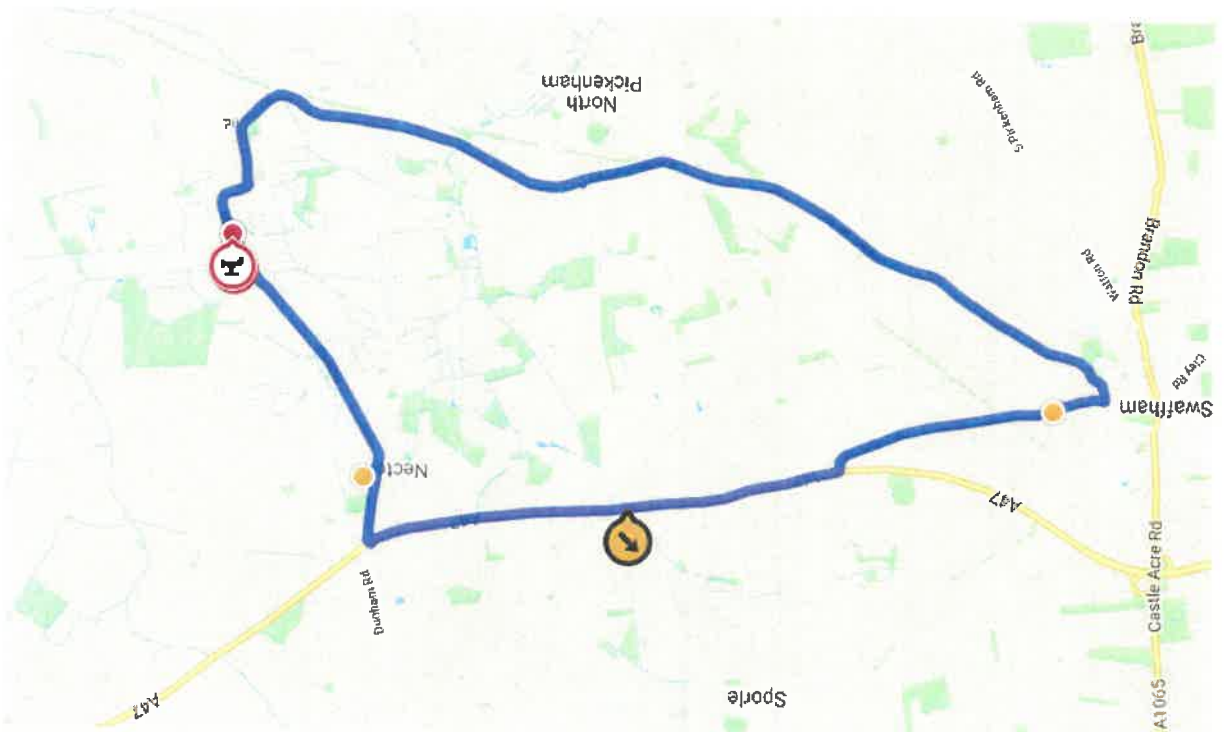

(HOLME HALE) (EMERGENCY NOTICE)
TEMPORARY TRAFFIC RESTRICTION 2020
Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984 – Section 14(2)

In accordance with the provisions of Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act, 1984, the Norfolk County Council HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that owing to a burst water main the use by vehicles of the Cook Road from its junction with Red Lion Close northwards for 200 metres in the PARISH OF HOLME HALE will be temporarily prohibited from 21st February 2020 to 27th February 2020 for the duration of the works, expected to be about 7 days within the period. If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 21 days.


Alternative route is via: Cook Road, School Road, Station Road, Swaffham Road, North Pickenham Road, Necton Road, Hale Road, Tuns Road, A47 From J A1075/ B1135 To Dualling At Swaffham Bypass, Norwich Road, A47 From Castle Acre Road To Necton Parish Boundary (Necton/ Swaffham/ Holme Hale/ North Pickenham/ Sporle with Palgrave).

(If necessary the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date of the Order)

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.
