District Councillor David Ashcroft was in attendance and reported on a recent presentation from The King's Arms who work with young people who have/or are at risk of being excluded from school by offering guidance and mentoring to them. The council awarded approximately £6,000 to this charity and reported great value for money on preventative costs of keeping young people in school and out of the judiciary system. To note District Councillor fund opens again in April.

19.149 SDNPA S106 Developers Contributions:

Cllr Brock provided us with an update in regards to his meeting with Sarah Nelson, Planning Projects Lead for South Downs National Park Authority. In total we have approx. £12k which is broken down into £8,375.80 in Transport Funds, Environmental Improvements £1,098 and Public Open Space £2,657. To note Sarah confirmed the Open Space funds could be used to repair the playground and the Transport Funds could be used for footpaths, stiles and kissing gates. Environmental Improvements fund could be used on improvements to village hall but not maintenance of village hall. **Proposed: Cllr Malin. Seconded: Cllr Brock.**

19.150 Playground/Kompan issue -

The Parish Council considered an update on the repairs on the playground. It was **RESOLVED** to accept the 50/50 split with Kompan on the replacement timbers and to have delivered to Manor Farm. To get new quote from suppliers for not supplying the timbers and to agree requotes of A and B at the next meeting. To note there has been an offer of a donation from The East Worldham School Educational Charity to help fund the playground in regards to repairs or a bench. **Action: Cllr Bagnell/Clerk**
