As an example of when being part of the NHW Goup is useful, some while ago, there was a major water leak in Wheelers Lane resulting in the water supply being cut off from properties in this lane. The water company delivered bottled water to Wheelers Lane and I was able to send out an email to everybody advising where the bottled water was located. Also, we are made aware of road closures etc in the local area via the Parish Council Clerk and these are sent out the NHW Goup when received.
