Bewdley is alive with music and events throughout the year. In Jubilee Gardens visitors can enjoy great quality free Sunday afternoon concerts in the summer months. Past concerts have included styles such as Irish, Choir, Brass and Jazz. The annual Bewdley Festival week in October is a must see, as is the regular Music in the Hall concerts, beer festivals, carnival and annual fireworks display.

**Food & Drink**

Taste and enjoy delicious local produce from Bewdley's twice monthly Riverside Market and from the amazing deli, traditional off licence and old fashioned sweet shop. Enjoy the ambience of riverside pubs and eat in award winning restaurants serving British, Italian, Indian and Thai cuisine.



## Bewdley Museum

Situated in Load Street, this unique museum can be enjoyed by the whole family. Imaginative displays offer insight into the rich history of the town and the Wyre Forest area, whilst daily craft demonstrations help to bring that history to life. Entry is free.

## Riverside Market

Situated in Load Street and along the riverside, this fabulous market offers locally sourced food and drink, vintage, arts and crafts, gifts and collectibles and handmade treasures.

The market takes place on the first and third Sunday of the month and is a great addition to a leisurely Sunday afternoon visit alongside the river Severn.

Take a tour around Bewdley, soaking up the town's history and learning as you wander. The tour is easy on the legs and takes you to some hidden gems in and around the town centre.

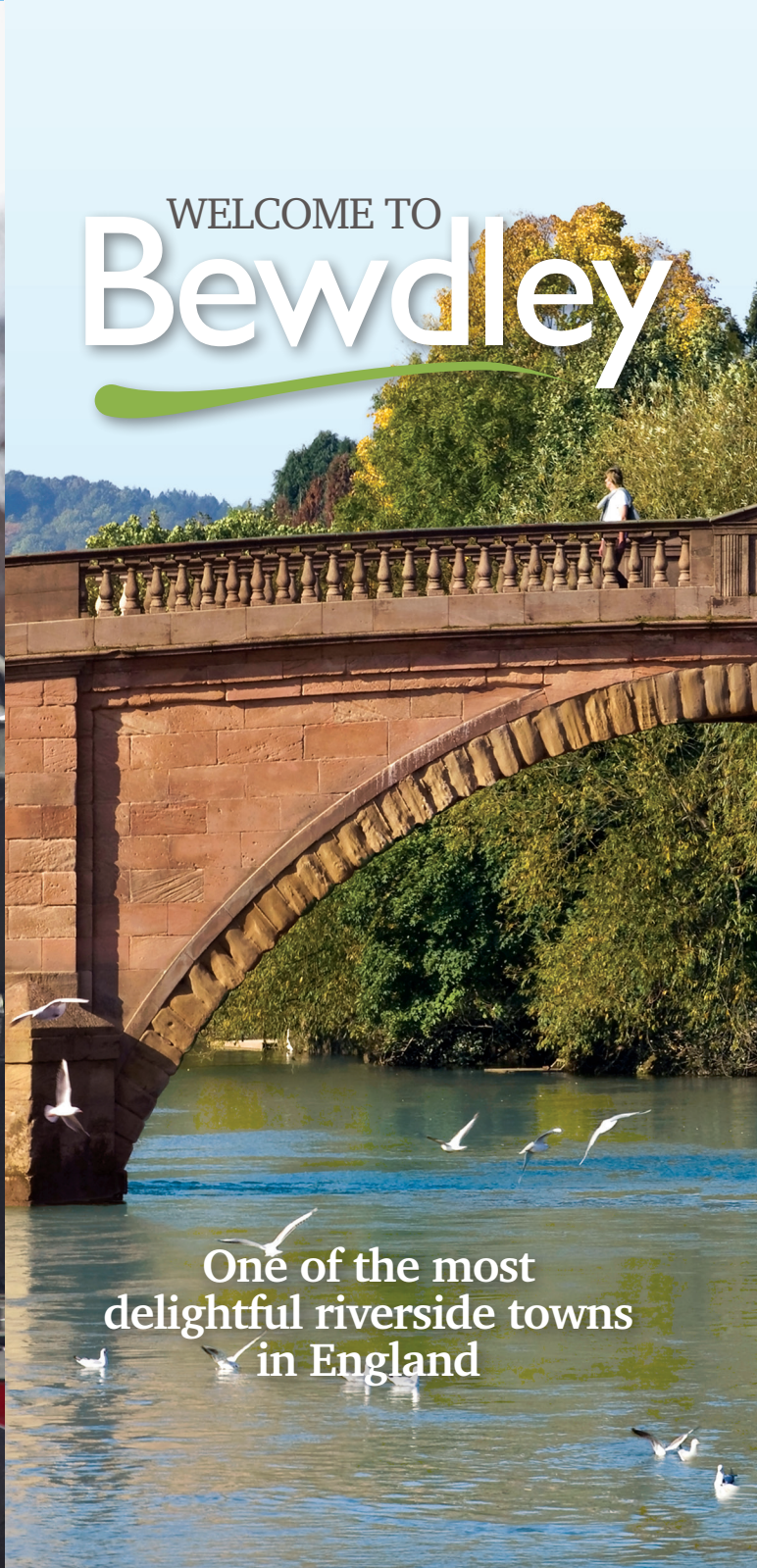

A vibrant modern market town today, Bewdley's roots reach back to medieval times with unique royal connections. Made rich by manufacturing and the trading of rope and pewter, by the seventeenth century Bewdley had become a busy inland port shipping goods to Bristol, Gloucester and the Severn estuary. Now it's better known for its beautiful riverside location, independent shops, markets, cosy pubs and historic buildings, as well as hosting a busy calendar of events and festivals throughout the year.
