- DD An invitation to the Senior Citizens Bowling Club Presentation night at Sinclair Bowling Club on 10th March had been received. To be raised at 2nd March meeting
- DD The green. DD concerned that the minutes of the Gaskell Recreation Ground Management Committee (GRGMC) show that contractors would be meeting on site. No invitation to MWBC had been received. Club members had topped the green by Flymo. Maintenance by GRGMC will involve cutting grass to utility standard. DD asked for members to list hours worked on the green in the hope that the £ rent will be reduced pro-rata.
- GRGMC is considering seeking grant funding from sponsors in exchange for displaying their names
- The pavilion accommodation needs to be reviewed. A working party will be needed for maintenance works.
- DD reported that GRGMC intends to meet Much Wenlock Cricket Club and MWBC, but nothing had been heard yet. There was interest in the GRGMC's intentions regarding grounds maintenance including the paths and hedges. DT Trees on the Linden Walk have been pruned but there was no sign of any work on the bowling green hedges and trees. Also concern about low hanging bough over pavilion. Hon Sec to contact GRGMC
- EM suggested moving gate in hedge. Proposal shelved.
- VH reported that polo shirts can be bought for £8.95 and sweatshirts for £13.95 each. Alternatively £20 for one of each. After a lengthy discussion it was decided that the strip would be purple with gold logo. Measurements would be given on 2nd March when quantities could be decided.
- RM reported that two floodlight bulbs were not working. Agreed to purchase RM four bulbs
