Dress Code Please wear your Club Shirt and Navy as we may have media coverage for this event especially at the start/finish. It will get cold though overnight so please ensure you bring plenty of warm clothing if playing between 8PM and 8 AM, Also remember to bring a torch as the car park will be pitch black when the street lighting goes out.

6 Different Rinks will be used during the match changing every 4 hours, these rinks will all be marked out in advance by me before the start. They are not the normal rinks used by these numbers but show the sequence to be used.

Rinks 3-5 will be floodlit and the floodlights may need adjusting as the rinks change, also the batteries will need to be changed at some stage during the night.

Shots and ends to be recorded, there will be 2 scoreboards when the score reaches 50 then the second scoreboard will be used to record the number of 50's, and each time 50 ends are played. Scoreboards to be relocated when the rinks change.

If you have an asterisk by your name then you will be overall in charge should there be any public disturbance, which is unlikely but outlined in Glen's risk assessment.

There are no reserves other than someone on the support side stepping in; the fall back is continue with one short or revert to a pairs game temporarily. There is no cover for the eventuality of rain so play may need to be suspended.
