Full discussion regarding the access, storage and location of access took place within the meeting. There has been access over buried railway sleepers at the side of the house next door to Cresswell Ices. Discussions around the type of wheelchairs that are good to use also took place.

More discussions around this is required.

Discussion around if there can be a power supply added - this is to be discussed further. Queries regarding solar powered chairs were also discussed.

Cllr Laing contacted Danny Goodall to discuss the Village fishing boat access and if the parish council would be allowed to complete some ground works on the track to make this more accessible as this is currently too steep to use. NCC is to install a short section of boardwalk and is expected to be in place by the end of June. Once this has been completed the groundworks can start.
