5. Matters Arising from 7th April 2015

a) Footpaths and stiles:

Hazeldene bridle way, the Clerk has contacted Mr Hope who explained that KCC had been out to the farm. The new bridge by the kissing gate is to be put in place. Mr Hope asked the representative from KCC to check the gate at the entrance of the bridle way. When the original works had been under-taken the work was carried out incorrectly with the posts being cut off, so not put into the ground deep enough, so after a while the posts began to move so the horse-catch did not work properly. Mr Hope has requested that KCC replace the existing gate and install a new gate and posts. KCC have the measurements and we await works to commence.

Brook gate, the footpath sign is now in the ditch awaiting renewal.

Green Wickets, while awaiting the outcome from Richard King checking with KCC about the possibility of diverting the footpath, Peter has offered to visit the owners. **Action** Richard King, Peter Rawlinson

b) **Highways**:

Peter Rawlinson and Richard Wall are still working on the mapping of drains within the village, they are awaiting maps to compare from KCC. The Clerk has been contacted by highways with their list of the number of drains/gullies they believe are within Egerton.

After a request by the Clerk to KCC for a map showing drains KCC responded that it would be too expensive to provide maps to each location. Richard Wall will contact KCC to check if his information can be matched to KCC information.

The Clerk has requested some signage/chevrons be placed along the roadside at Brook gate, Forstal road. Highways have responded that as no accidents have actually been reported highways will not provide chevrons or signage. The Clerk will write again to try and find out costs of signs and if it will be possible for Egerton Parish Council to erect signs. The response from Highways that the cost would not be known until the works were carried out.
