12/238 CONSIDERATION OF THE REQUEST FROM THE LANGTON GREEN SPORTS CLUB (LGSC) TO USE THE LANGTON GREEN RECREATION GROUND (LGRG) FOR THEIR FOOTBALL FIESTA ON THE WEEKEND OF 30TH JUNE/1ST JULY 2012:

The Clerk explained that the LGSC had been forced to cancel the Fiesta on the weekend of 9/10 June because the field owned by Ashurst Place, which was used for parking up to 500 cars was flooded. It was a late decision and the only weekend they can hold the event is the weekend of 30th June/1st July and no cricket matches were planned that weekend. Permission was **AGREED**
