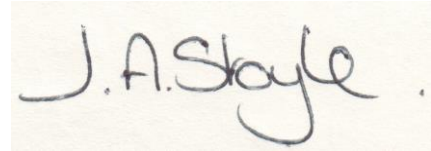

P19/S2685/FUL Lobb Farm Access Road to Lobb Farm Tetsworth South OX9 7BE: The proposed development is for a Gas Fired Electricity Generating Facility with the ability to generate up to 49.99 MW of electricity. A low carbon flexible generating facility using gas reciprocating engines. The facility will generate electricity principally for the regional distribution network in times of generation shortfall and/or high demand. (as clarified by additional information submitted 10 September 2019, 12 September 2019 and 22 October 2019). Addition information received 5 & 12 February 2020. Consultation end date 6th March 2020, target decision date 6th May 2020.

P19/S4640/FUL Land rear of Hilltop Cottage Tiddington OX9 2LG: New 3-bedroom house and detached garage on land to the rear of Hilltop Cottage. Consultation end date 5th February 2020, target decision date 24th March 2020.

P20/S0436/RM Hartgrove Oxford Road OX9 2LH: Application for reserve matters in relation to outline planning application P17/S3359/O for the erection of 2 double storey dwellings. Consultation end date 27th February 2020, extension given to the 12th March 2020, target decision date 30th March 2020.
