As mentioned – given the existing Sharps bin – 30l which is picked up bi-monthly is no longer sufficient to hold the amount of needles etc - Graham asked me to look into either increasing the size of the bin or the frequency of the pick up to help resolve this situation.

Here are the quotes for consideration:

Current contact $-6 \times 30l$ bin lifts with annual Waste Transfer notes = £327 per annum net (renewed this month already)

If we were to change size or frequency of pick-ups:

Increase size - bi-monthly lifts - 6×601 bin lifts with annual Waste transfer note = £426 per annum Increase frequency - 4 weekly lifts - 13×301 bin lifts with annual Waste Transfer Note = £708.50 per annum
