Club Competitions

Aim

To encourage ALL members, regardless of their bowling ability to take part.

Entry

Entry to the competitions is made by submitting a completed entry form and entry fee to the Competitions Secretary before 30 April.

Selection of Rink

To be drawn from the bag of rink numbers.

Competitions

Men – Tolchard – 4 wood singles, first to score 21 shots.

Men – Hamlyn – 2 wood singles, first to score 21 shots.

Men – Hoskings – 4 wood singles, first to score 21 shots.

Ladies – Williams – 4 wood singles, first to score 21 shots.

Ladies – Grogan – 4 wood singles, first to score 21 shots.

Ladies 2 wood – 2 wood singles, 21 ends.

Mixed – Vic Manfield Memorial – 4 wood singles, best of 3 sets. Each set shall be 5 ends. In the case of a drawn set, then an extra end shall be played.

Mixed – Les Cann Over 55's – 4 wood singles, first to score 21 shots.

Mixed – Pairs – 4 wood pairs, 21 ends.

Mixed – Novices – 4 wood singles, first to 21 shots. Only open to members who **have not** previously won a competition.

Dress

Greys with club shirts.

Schedule

All rounds of each competition will have “play by” dates set by the Competitions Secretary. All finals, with the exception of the Vic Manfield Memorial Trophy will be played on finals weekend.

The Vic Manfield Memorial Trophy final will be played each year on the Vic Manfield Memorial Day.

Challenger

The challenger is the player, or pair, who appears above their opponent on the competition sheet. It is the responsibility to arrange the fixture and a marker if appropriate and offer their opponent 2 dates.

Penalties

Any disputes should be referred to the Competitions Secretary, whose decision is final.

Markers Duties and Responsibilities

Ensure the mat is correctly positioned and centered.

Ensure the jack is of length.

Mark touchers and remove dead woods.

Answer questions from the player on the mat. Answers should be brief, yes or no if possible. Do not offer information.

Measure if asked. Players decide, although the final decision rests with the marker.

Complete the scorecard and keep the scoreboard up to date.
