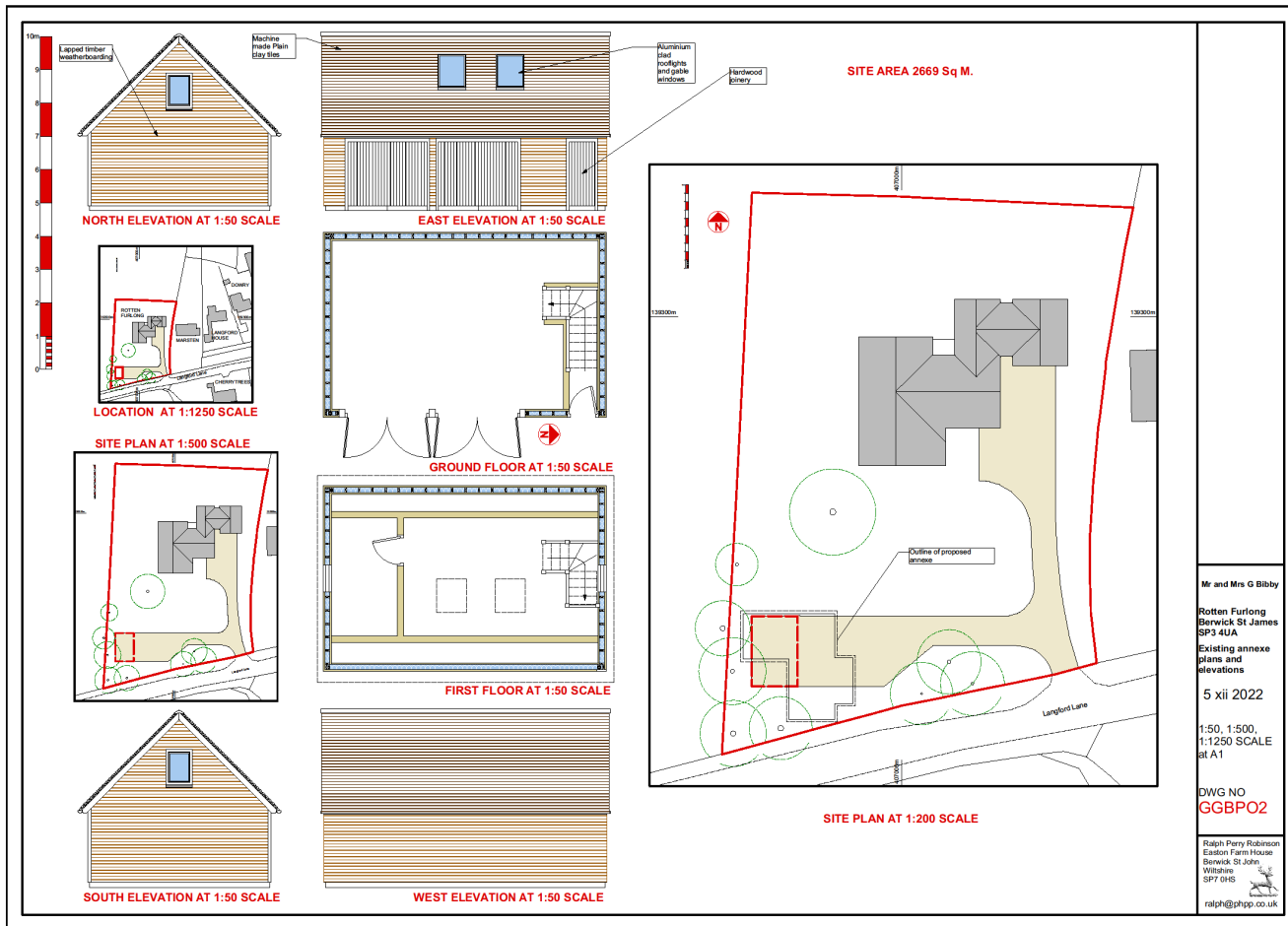

## Planning Applications Magna House update

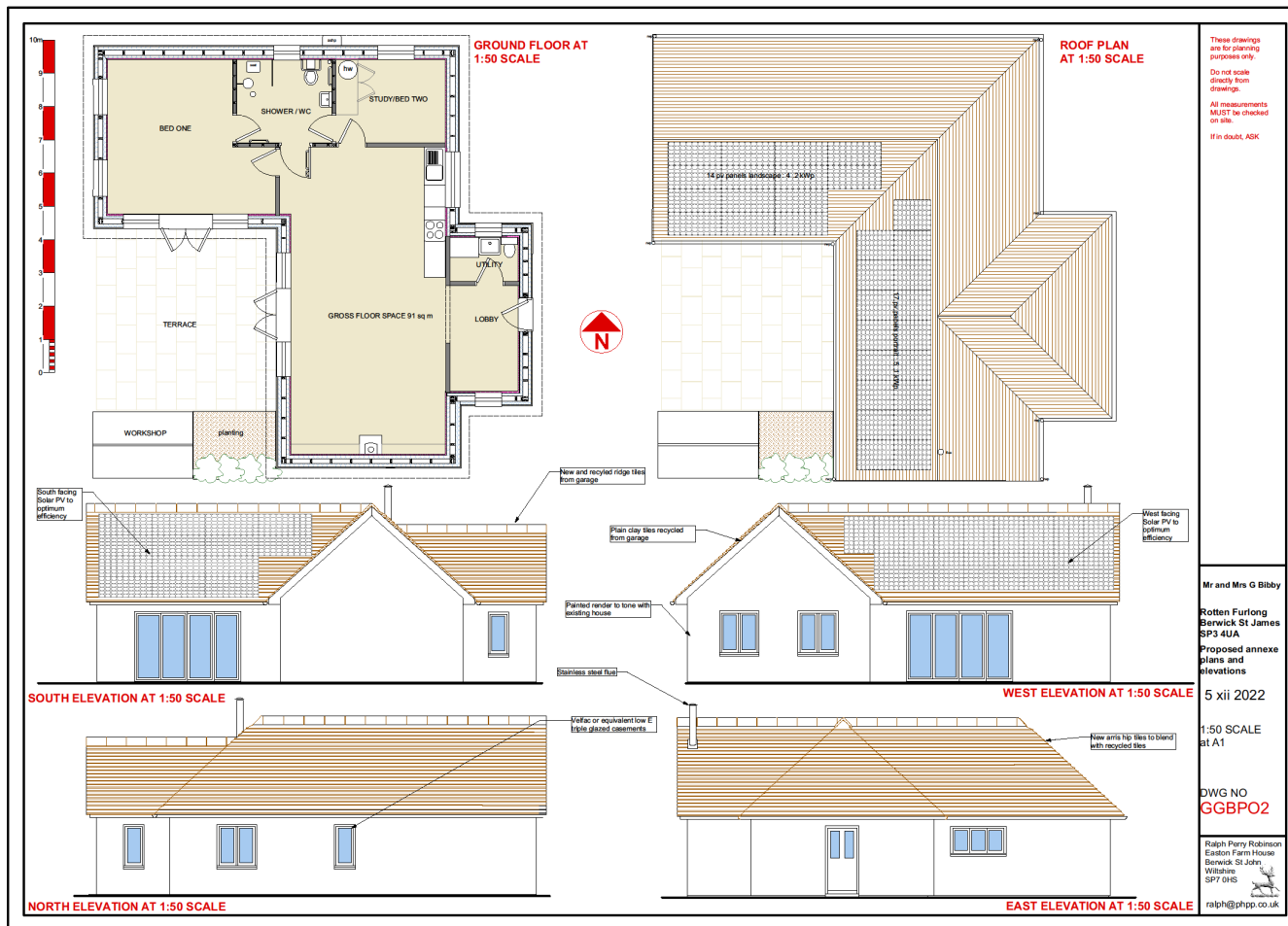
