Harvey Adams was born 1883 Echt, Scotland. The family moved to Halling sometime before 1901.

Father Alexander was buried 03-Nov-1926 at St John The Baptist, Halling, Aged 75 years old. Address was Great Buckland, Meopham.

Mother Mary Jane was buried 21-Nov-1932 at St John The Baptist, Halling. Aged 84 years old. Address was 54 Harold Street, Norwood (late of this parish)

10th (Service) Battalion

The 10th (Service) Battalion, better known as the Stock Exchange Battalion, was formed in August 1914 when 1,600 members of the London Stock Exchange and others from the area joined up: 742 were killed or missing in action on the Western Front.
