I am pleased to be able to report the following;

Residents Correspondence:

An enquiry was received relating to the responsibility for maintenance of Green Lane. This has been confirmed with OCC Highways as an 'unadopted' road and therefore maintenance is the responsibility of the residents involved.

Burial Ground:

There have been two requests for the installation of memorials, both of which have been approved and will be conducted during the next few months.

Defibrillators:

None of the units have required use and are all available for use.

Fix My Street:

There are currently three reports under investigation. Two of these relate to pathways with the remaining report linked to the Green Lane enquiry.

General:

35 members of the public attended the Annual Assembly of Uffington Parish.

Approval for co-option of both existing vacancies for the role of Parish Councillor has been obtained and these should be completed prior to the Uffington Parish Council Annual Meeting being held on Monday 12th May. (59/25)

The memorial bench for M Leyland has been installed on the southern edge of the pond area. A donation equal to the cost of the bench has been received.

Following completion of the Oxfordshire County Council Elections, Emma Markham has been elected as the County Representative for the Division of Shrivenham.
