Chebbard Farm Culvert (Cheselbourne C34)

Maintenance work to Chebbard Farm Culvert (see map for location) is planned to start shortly. A road closure is proposed to come into effect from 04 June 2018 and is expected to remain in place until 30 June 2018. The work will be to replace the existing culvert, headwalls and parapet rails. Construction of the scheme will be carried out by the operations department of Dorset Highways, which is based at Charminster, and staff from this office will supervise the work.

The traffic diversion route will be: From north of closure, continue on C34 through Cheselbourne and past village school to crossroads at Charlie's Patch. Turn right into Streetway Lane (C110). Continue east on road to junction at Eastfield. Turn right (C110) and continue south to Dewlish. At Church Street crossroads, turn right onto D20666 and continue west to junction with C34. Turn right to meet road closure. The reverse route applies. The closure and diversion route will be signed when operational (see map overleaf).

Unfortunately, with this sort of work, some inconvenience may be caused but we will endeavour to keep it to a minimum. If you feel the work is likely to cause any particular problem, which could be helped by special arrangements (e.g. for anyone with a mobility problem or for special deliveries you might be expecting), please contact me or the construction team's representative.

Should you have any problems or reasons for complaint whilst work is going on, it would be helpful if you could let me or the construction team's representative know at once. We will then be able to ensure that the earliest possible action is taken to overcome them. If you want to discuss any issues regarding this scheme, please contact me. The construction team's representative is Tony Price, who can be contacted on 01305 228100. If any emergencies occur out of normal working hours, please contact 01305 221000 and your message will be passed to the relevant personnel.
