## TheFED 2010 London MiniFest

This one day event will take place at Faraday House in Holborn, London on Saturday 6th November 2010.

This venue is fully accessible to disabled people, with accessible toilets, wheelchair ramps and a lift to all floors.

The day will include a wide selection of workshops to do with writing, publishing and performance. There will also be plenty of time for networking with other community writing groups from all over the UK and the US, meeting old friends and making new ones.

The day will conclude with a 2-hour celebratory performance evening with all attendees being invited to read or perform a short piece of their own work if they wish to do so.

The attendance fee is £10 in advance (or £15 on the day) and this includes a buffet lunch, refreshments and all workshops and materials.

GROW will once again be hiring a coach for anyone who would like to attend this event. However, this year the coach tickets will be FREE to all GROW members! (£10 each to non-GROW members & London Day-Trippers)

The GROW Executive Committee hopes that by subsidising the attendance costs of this event to our members, we will encourage and enable many more people from our groups to come with us this year.

### **GROW CALENDAR**

We have now sold all 60 copies of the GROW 2010 Calendar. It proved to be a very popular project with many of our members purchasing extra copies to give to friends and family as Christmas gifts. We have already started work on a new GROW Calendar for 2011.

### **REFLECTION 2010**

Work has already started on the 2010 GROW anthology, 'Reflection'

The Wednesday and Friday groups have been designing 'corner borders' which will provide a visual echo of the Reflection' theme.

We have already started the voice recording and we hope to get as many people as possible to read their own work for the 'Reflection' DVD.

We are inviting all GROW members to submit their ideas and designs for the front cover. This could be an original piece of artwork or photograph and should be based upon the theme of 'Reflection.'

All submitted cover designs will be displayed in the GROW website Gallery and GROW members will be able to vote for their favourite design. The design that gets the most votes will be used for the front cover of the book and it will also be printed on the front of the accompanying DVD.

The deadline for all submissions (both writing and cover designs) is 31<sup>st</sup> May 2010.
