The personal information we collect and how we use it

Disclosure

The Council will only hold your information for as long as necessary for the purpose for which it was collected.

Personal information is not disclosed to third parties unless this is indicated on the web page and/or relevant form at the point of collecting the information or as required or allowed by law

Use of cookies

The Council may use cookies on its site. A cookie is a text file that identifies your computer to the server. Cookies in themselves do not identify the individual user, just the computer used.

If the settings on your software that you are using to view this website (your browser) are adjusted to accept cookies we take this, and your continued use of our website, to mean that you are fine with this.

Cookies are not used to collect any personal information.
