3. Annual Report of the Parish Council 2025-26, presented by the Chairman, Councillor D Roberts

Cllr Dave Roberts provided an Annual Report which covered the following:

- Elections held in 2025. Cllr Paul Cordey was elected as a new member of the Council.
- Thanked Clerk and fellow Councillors for their hard work over last 12 months.
- 4 new houses have been built which will be an asset to the village. 4 more have been granted planning permission.
- Many meetings have been held re. proposed development NE of Bradford Drive, PC is still awaiting outcome of planning applications.
- Sewage smell. STaR Housing are starting to listen to the PC and we are hopeful there will be a meeting to discuss this with them in the next week or so.
- Speeding - lots of police checks have been held in Knockin. Many motorists have been caught speeding and police enforcement is taking place.
- SC services and asset transfer plans – Chairman is of opinion the PC has insufficient resources to oversee taking on additional activities from SC.
- New PC noticeboard has been purchased, and older one has been refurbished, and the old one on the Village Hall has been relocated to the bus shelter.
- The Chairman also thanked Cllr David Mitcham, who is retiring from the Council, for all his hard work on the Council and wished him all the best for the future.
