## Private William Bernard Peatman 20032

William was born in Gunthorpe and his birth registered in the October Quarter of 1891. In the 1901 census he was living aged 9 in Gunthorpe with his Father Zebedee, Mother Sarah and Brothers Frederick and Thomas. By the 1911 Census, aged 20, he was a single man working and living on a farm at Kneeton. He was employed as an Under Wagoner.

William was killed in action serving with the Sherwood Foresters 2<sup>nd</sup> /5<sup>th</sup> Notts. and Derby Battalion on 26<sup>th</sup> September1917 aged 30. His death is remembered on the Tyne Cot Memorial on panel 99to 102and 162to162A. There is a discrepancy of his parents names on the Commonwealth War Graves data base. His address is listed as East Bridgford on his death certificate.
