

Temporary Road Closure - Broad Street, Lyminge - 25th July 2022 for 42 Days

It will be necessary to close part of Broad Street, Lyminge from 25th July 2022 with estimated completion by 4th September 2022.

Broad Street, Lyminge will be closed for the entire length.

The alternative route is Station Road, Canterbury Road, Longage Hill, The Minnis, High Minnis, Mockbeggar, B2068 Stone Street/Stanford Bypass/Stanford Intersection, A20 Ashford Road/Sandling Road, Beachborough and vice versa.

The closure is required for the safety of the public and workforce while drainage works are undertaken by Walker Construction UK Ltd.
