a. <u>CIIr Motley, Shropshire Council:</u> ClIr Motley was informed that there had been no progress on the highway's issues discussed at the last meeting including the Blacksmiths Lane hole, Titterhill verge and cars parked on the grass verge in Stanton Lacy. She alerted the Council to the Community Governance Review that will take place after the elections in May. She encouraged the Council to consider joint working with other parishes and to look at boundary anomalies.
