

If you need help with transport, this is for you!

Eythorne Parish Council has taken out an annual membership subscription with **Thanet Community Transport Association** so that all residents of Eythorne Parish, (everyone who lives in Barfreestone, Elvington & Eythorne), can use the scheme. This means that residents will not have to pay for individual membership to use the dial-a ride service but will just have to pay for the journeys that they make.

In order to use the service you telephone 01843 602030 to book your ride, stating that you are a member of Eythorne Parish Council Group. The office staff will take your booking and confirm times with you, office hours are between 9am and 4pm, Monday to Friday.

The service is door to door and can be used for medical appointments, day centres, shopping, school and college runs and trips. People who are no longer able to do their own shopping can be provided with a personal shopper to collect your list, go to the supermarket of your choice and do your shopping and then return with it to you. The service can be used for individuals or groups.
