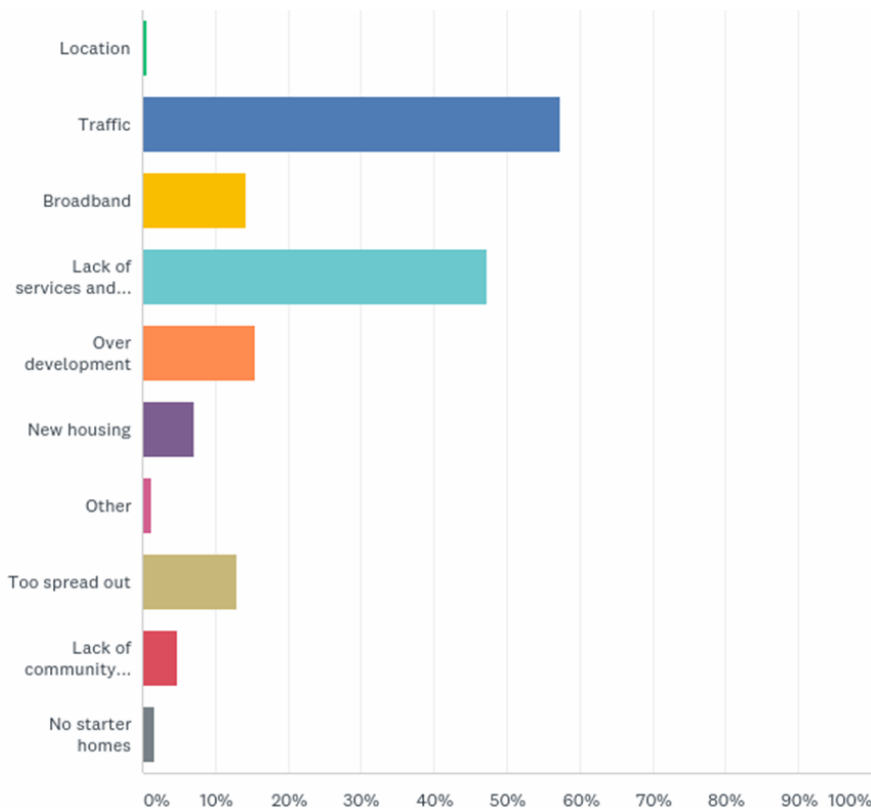


**Residents Survey “Post it” comments 18.11.2017 against Q2 questionnaire outcomes.  
 “What do you dislike about living in Chelford”**



The bollards are a solution to a problem that does not really exist & don't help traffic flow [and they eg pollution] on the main roads.
